Native Turf and Groundcover Recommendations Communities near Atlanta, GA

This area is located in the Piedmont within the Eastern Temperate Forests Ecoregion.

Good individual species that are native substitutes for Bermudagrass include:

Eragrostis spectabilis (purple lovegrass)

Juncus tenuis (path/poverty rush)

Sporobolus junceus (pinewoods dropseed)

Carex pensylvanica (Pennsylvania sedge)

Carex albicans (white-tinge sedge)

Carex radiata (Eastern star sedge)

Blooming low native groundcover alternatives:

Salvia lyrata (lyreleaf sage)

Sisyrinchium angustifolium (blue-eyed grass)

Viola soraria (common blue violet)

Seed mixes that contain some combinations of the above species include:

Prescribed lawn-alternative seed mixes do not seem to be available in Georgia. We suggest contacting one of these seed suppliers to obtain individual seed species or create a customized mix comprised of some of the individual species listed above.
